Innovation Week Tanzania is overseen by the Ministry of Education, Science, and Technology (MoEST) through the Department of Science, Technology, and Innovation (DSTI), this platform has evolved from its inception in 2015 into a distinguished national event.

This year, the Innovation Week will be held in various locations across the country, independently organised by innovation ecosystem partners, leading towards the “Education, Skills and Innovation Climax” that will be held in Tanga region under the overall coordination of MoEST. Innovation Week Sponsorship

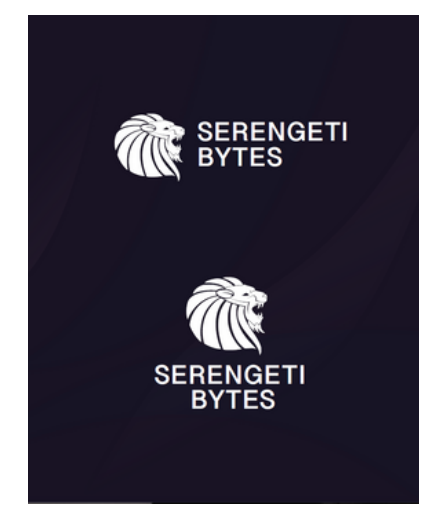
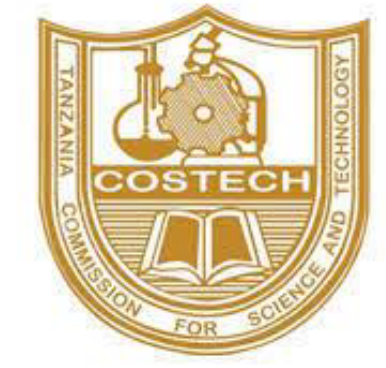
